01. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF ORDINARY BOARD MEETING.

To confirm the minutes of Ordinary Board meeting held on 10/05/2021.

RESOLUTION

Considered and confirmed.

02. BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 2021-2022 (REVISED) AND FOR THE YEAR 2022-2023 (ORIGINAL).

To note and approve the Budget Estimates prepared under Rule 20 & Rule 21 of the Cantonment Board Account Rules, 2020 for the year 2021-2022 (Revised) & 2022-2023 (Original). The Budget Estimates alongwith all relevant papers are placed on the table.

RESOLUTION

CEO read out the Budget Estimates provision made in the year 2021-22 (R) and 2022-23 (O). Board discussed it at length and approved the Budget Estimates unanimously.

Further noted the unclaimed balance deposit shown in the deposit registers beyond three years be transferred to Cantt. Fund Account U/s 185 (3) of CBAR 2020.

03. CONSTRUCTION OF SCIENTIFIC SANITARY LAND FILL SITE AT DAREWADI TRENCHING GROUND IN AHMEDNAGAR CANTONMENT BOARD AND OPERATION & MAINTENANCE FOR TWO YEARS AFTER COMPLETION OF PROJECT- IVth Call UNDER 15 FINANCE COMMISSION.

To consider and approve e-tender received for Proposed Construction of Scientific Sanitary landfill site at Darewadi Trenching ground Ahmednagar Cantonment and Operation & maintenance for two years after completion of project in two bid system i.e. Technical & financial. This office has invited online tender vide Tender ID : 2021_DGDE_618480_1. In first two calls no response was received. Again this office recalled the tender for third time vide letter No. ANR/ SAN / 2021-22, dated 15-04-2021 and tender notice ANR/ SAN-LANDFILL /2021-22 dated 16-04-2021. In response to the same, Two bidders quoted their rates through online in stipulated period. But No one had the work experiences for the work of Scientific Sanitary land fill site. So IVth call was published vide this office letter No.. ANR/ SAN / 2021, dated 10-05-2021 & tender notice ANR/ SAN-LANDFILL /2021-22 dated 11-05-2021. Date of opening was 21-05-2021. In response to the same, Two tenderers have quoted their rates through online in stipulated period. But one of them do not have the work experiences for the work of Scientific Sanitary land fill site. The second bidder fulfil all criterias.

I) The detailed comparative statement for Proposed Construction of Scientific Sanitary landfill site at Darewadi Trenching ground Ahmednagar Cantonment is as below:-

It is observed that the bidders have quoted the prices in the prescribed format. **RATHORE CONSTRUCTION, Jhansi has quoted lowest rates 30.18% above MES SSR 2010.** As per CE,Pune Zone the forecast percentage over MES SSR 2010 for June 2020 quarter ending is 70 % above.

It is observed that the bidders have quoted the prices in the prescribed format. **RATHORE CONSTRUCTION, Jhansi has quoted lowest rates of Rs.69,300/- per month.**

04. ANNUAL TENDER FOR MAKING VARIOUS FABRICATION WORK IN THE AHMEDNAGAR CANTONMENT BOARD.

To consider and approve rates obtained from the e-tender for making various fabrication works in the Ahmednagar Cantonment Board for further period of one year. This office has invited e-tender for making fabrication work through online by using Central Government e-procurement portal under tender id 2020_DGDE_598833_4. The tender notice was published in the news papers for wide publicity. In response to the same, 02 nos. of bidders have been participated in the tender process. The existing vehicle tyres have been too worsted and due to this vehicles are puncture frequently. Therefore the work of day to day sanitation is getting hampered, hence is it necessary to replace the following vehicle tyres.

Therefore this office have invited bid on the GeM and following bidders have submitted their bids.

06. PROCUREMENT OF OXYGEN CONCENTRATOR FROM GEM.

To consider and approve the expenditure of Rs.1,10,000/- for procurement of 02 Nos. of Oxygen Concentrator from GeM for Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Cantt. General Hospital on emergency basis to prevent Covid-19. The product has been compared on the GeM and placed an order to L1 seller. The expenditure will be incurred from the funds received from State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).

07. TENDERS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF COMPOUND WALL AT DAREWADI AND SULABH SUVIDHA KENDRA.

To consider status of tenders for construction of Compound wall at Darewadi & Sulabh Suvidha Kendra.

This office invited tender for works of Construction of Compound wall at Darewadi and Sulabh Suvidha Kendra at Momin Gualli, Bhingar separately. After technical evaluation it is found that 10 bidders in work in Compound wall and 05 bidders in work of Sulabh Suvidha Kendra were qualified technically. Both tenders were processed for financial evaluation. At this time it is noticed that 08 out of 10 bidders in work of compound wall and three out of 05 bidders in work of Sulabh Suvidha Kendra quoted rates in negative. However no one has submitted additional performance security deposit as per tender conditions. (Both works Comparative statement enclosed herewith). One Shri Vijay D Godake submitted the additional performance security deposit on 18-05-2021 which cannot be considered as it is not submitted in financial bid folder at the time of submission of tender.

In the meantime Sectional Engineer- I (report Enclosed) came to know about Office Memorandum published by Dept of expenditure procurement policy division , Govt Of India dated 12-11-2020. (Copy enclosed) In the said Office

Memorandum it is specifically mentioned that **No provision should be kept in the bid document regarding additional security deposit incase of abnormally low bids**. Due to oversight the condition of submission of additional performance security deposit remained in the subject tender documents.

After financial evaluation it is noticed that the bid for Construction of compound wall has gone as much below as (-) 20.20 % and in work of Sulabh Suvidha Kendra, it has gone to (-) 16.99 %. If it is decided to reject these bids due to non submission of additional performance security deposit the lowest eligible rate in both the tender is (-) 0.99 % and (+) 0.99 % respectively. Therefore in this situation Board may face huge financial losses i.e. Rs.8,72,543/- in work of Compound wall &Rs. 7,26,741/- in work of Sulabh Suvidha Kendra

Board to take appropriate decision

Considered. The matter discussed in detail and resolved that both these tenders be cancelled and a fresh short tender notices be published inviting tender by deleting / amending the condition of additional performance security deposit as per the Ministry of Finance office memorandum.

08. ARBITRATION CASE FILED BY M/S. H.G. PATHAN, CONTRACTOR AGAINST CANTT. BOARD.

Ref: application dated 30/03/2021 received from M/s H.G. Pathan Contractor through its authorized signatory Mr. Shahid Pathan, R/O Nagardeole, Ahmednagar.

The contractor M/s H.G. Pathan through Mr. Shahid A. Pathan has filled writ petition No. 7989 of 2020 in the High Court of judicature of Bombay Bench at Aruangabad. Hon'ble High Court passed an order directing M/s H.G. Pathan to file petition before Arbitrator as per clause in Contract agreement. The Contract period was in the year 2019-20.

Accordingly M/s H.G. Pathan has submitted application for Arbitration on 30/10/2020. As per section 325 to 327 of Cantt. Act,2006 the Board has to form committee of Arbitration with nomination of 02 members nominated by the Board and 02 persons nominated by other party concerned with chairman who

shall be not in the service of Govt. or the Board and who shall be nominated by the officer commanding the station.

The detailed report of Sectional Engineer is placed on table.

Board to resolve appropriately.

10. CLEANING OF BHINGAR NALAH

To consider and approve the work of cleaning of Bhingar Nalah. The Sangama River mostly known as Bhingar Nalah which enter in Cantonment limit near to cremation ground of Ahmednagar Cantonment and passes alongwith northern side of ward no.5 and ward no. 3. The nalah from cremation ground to Gogamedhi (Nagar-Pathardi Road Bridge) filled with lot of soil/silt and various shrubs. Due to this there is no proper flow of the waste water and at various places water logging is seen. In mansoon season there are good chances of floods

and water enters in nearby slum area. The stagnated water is the main cause to breeding of mosquitoes and thus various diseases.

The Cantonment Board carried the work of canalization of Bhingar nalah in the year 2007. As per section 209 (3) of Cantonment Act 2006, For the purpose of enlarging, deepening or otherwise repairing or maintaining any such drain or sewage collection work so much of the sub-soil appertaining therto as may be necessary for the said purpose shall be deemed also vest in the Board.

Ahmednagar Cantonment Board vide CBR No. 15 dated 29/06/2020 approved the annual rate contract for hiring of JCB (Excavator) machine & Poclain machine i.e. Rs. 899/- per hour and Rs.2800/- per hour respectively. It is require to hire poclain machine for approx. 130 hrs for cleaning the nalah and removing shrubs/silt/mud etc. Approx. estimate for the said work will come to Rs. 4.00 lakh.
